

DOCOMO TEAM DANDELION RACING Team Release

Race Report 2024/11/9 Rd-8 SUZUKA circuit

Weather: Fine Temperature: 21°C, 21cars

The final 7th event of the season was held as the 22th JAF Grand Prix, which contained Rd8 on Saturday and Rd9 on Sunday.

On each day, the race started soon after QF had finished. Tsuboi, who topped in the Drivers' standings, was followed by Makino by 14.5 points, and Nojiri came behind by 2 points.

Ohta in the pole position made a steadfast start, and went into First Corner first. Makino avoided Iwase whose engine had stalled in front of him, and finished the opening lap in 3rd.

On L10 when the pit-stop window opened, Ohta on top was driving at a quick pace with more than 5 sec gap to the second.

The team called Makino in third into the pits first, and sent him off to the track without any mistake.

However, he was overcut by Tuboi, who came into the pits on L11.

Ohta recorded 'super lap' again and again after the pit-stop to outdistance Tsuboi far behind.

On the other hand, Makino stayed in 3rd even though he kept putting pressure on Tsuboi.

From the middle stage of the race, 6 cars retired and the safety car came in twice.

Ohta won this survival race for the first time this season, recording 'pole to finish' and the fastest lap.

Makino, who finished in third, kept the possibility of winning the championship title in the final race tomorrow.

DOCOMO TEAM DANDELION RACING moved into the lead because of a 'one-three finish' of Ohta and Makino, and will go into the final game aiming for the double titles tomorrow.
